Dear Reader,

limited resources, especially time, it will be awhile before they are published, but do not be discouraged if you do not see such right away.

Speaking of guidelines, one such guideline that we need to retract is the addressing of everyone's questions. It was stated in the previous newsletter that we would address everyone's questions through our publication, however, in light of some recent attacks of character, both personally and on the ministry, I must state that not every question will be addressed now. The reason is stated in the following found in the Spirit of Prophecy:

EDITOR NOTE:

Many over the years have accused us standard bearers (who are crying aloud, showing the apostasy so none be deceived and be lost) as pulling random quotes to just cause trouble. Keep in mind that the Books of a New Order used to remove the pillars of our faith began with the introduction of the book, Questions on Doctrine in 1957.

The article is provided in the original state as found in Testimonies for the Church Containing Messages of Warning and Instruction to Seventhday Adventists, pages 36-42.

God has permitted the presentation of the combination of good and evil in "Living Temple" to be made to reveal the danger threatening us. The working that has been so ingeniously carried on he has permitted in order that certain developments might be made, and that it might be seen what a man can do with human minds when he has obtained their confidence as a physician. God has permitted the present crisis to come to open the eyes of those who desire to know the truth. He would have His people understand to what lengths the sophistry and devising of the enemy would lead.

Men have given to our leading physician allegiance that is due to God alone; and he has been permitted to show what selfexaltation will lead men to do. Scientific, spiritualistic sentiments, representing the Creator as an essence pervading all nature, have been given to our people, and have been received even by some who have had a long experience as teachers in the word of God. The results of this insidious

devising will break out again and again. There are many for whom special efforts will have to be put forth to free them from this specious deception.

I am now authorized to say that the time has come to take decided action. The development seen in the cause of God is similar to the development seen when Balaam caused Israel to sin just before they entered the promised land. How dangerous it is so to exalt any man that he becomes confused, and confuses the minds of others in regard to the truths that for the last fifty vears the Lord has been giving his people.

Few can see the meaning of the present apostasy. But the Lord has lifted the curtain, and has shown me its meaning, and the result that it will have if allowed to continue. We must now lift our voices in warning. Will our people acknowledge God as the supreme Ruler, or will they choose the misleading arguments and views that, when fully developed, make Him, in the minds of those who accept them, as nothingness?


These words were spoken to me in the night season. The sentiments in "Living Temple" regarding the personality of God have been received even by men who have had a long experience in the truth. When such men consent to eat of the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, we are no longer to regard the subject as a matter to be treated with the greatest delicacy. That those whom we thought sound in the faith should have failed to discern the specious, deadly influence of this science of evil, should alarm us as nothing else has alarmed us.

It is something that can not be treated as a small matter that men who have had so much

light, and such clear evidence as to the genuineness of the truth we hold, should become unsettled, and led to accept spiritualistic theories regarding the personality of God. Those doctrines, followed to their logical conclusion, sweep away the whole Christian economy. They estimate as nothing the light that Christ came from heaven to give John to give to His people. They teach that the scenes just before us are not of sufficient importance to be given special attention. They make of no effect the truth of heavenly origin, and rob the people of God of their past experiences, giving them instead a false science. {SpTB07 37.3}

During the past night, I have been shown more distinctly than ever before that these sentiments have been looked upon by some as the grand truths that are to be brought in and made prominent at the present time. I was shown a platform, braced by solid timbers, the truths of the word of God. Some one high in responsibility in the medical work was directing this man and that man to loosen the timbers supporting this platform. of no effect the plain word of God.

The tempter is working to gather together at Battle Creek as large a number as possible, hoping that they will receive false ideas of God and His work, and thus make of no effect the impression that God would have made in the minds of those engaged in the medical missionary work and in the gospel ministry. God abhors the great swelling words of vanity that have been spoken by those connected with the Sanitarium. The judgments of God have been visited upon Battle Creek, and these judgments call for humiliation rather than

for proud boasting and self-exaltation.

The heavenly messenger turned to those professing to be medical missionaries, and said, "How could you allow yourselves to be led blindfold? How could you so misrepresent the name you

bear? You have your Bibles. Why have you not reasoned from cause to effect? You have accepted theories that have led you away

from the truths that are to stamp their impress upon the characters of all Seventh-day Adventists. Your leader has been moving the foundation timbers one by one, and his reasoning would soon leave us with no certain foundation for our faith. He has not heeded the testimonies that God through His Spirit has given. The books of the Bible containing most important instruction are disregarded because they say so much about a personal God. He has not known whither his feet were tending. But in his recent writings, his tendencies toward pantheism have been revealed."

The enemy of souls has sought to bring in the supposition that a great reformation was to take place among Seventh-day Adventists, and that this reformation would consist in giving up the doctrines which stand as the pillars of our faith, and engaging in a process of reorganization. November 20, 1857, I was shown the people of God, and saw them mightily shaken. Some, with strong faith and agonizing cries, were pleading with God. Their countenances were pale, and marked with deep anxiety, expressive of their internal struggle. Firmness and great earnestness were expressed in their countenances, while large drops of perspiration fell from their foreheads. Now and then their faces would light up with the marks of God's approbation, and again the same solemn, earnest, anxious look would settle upon

Evil angels crowded around them, pressing

their darkness upon them, to shut out Jesus from their view, that their eyes might be drawn to the darkness that surrounded them, and they distrust God and next murmur against Him. Their only safety was in keeping their eyes directed upward. Angels of God had charge over His people, and as the poisonous atmosphere from the evil angels was pressed around these anxious ones, the heavenly angels were continually wafting their wings over them, to scatter the thick darkness.

Some, I saw, did not participate in this work of agonizing and pleading. They seemed indifferent and careless. They were not resisting the darkness around them, and it shut them in like a thick cloud. The angels of God left these, and I saw them hastening to the assistance of those who were struggling with all their energies to resist the evil angels, and trying to help themselves by calling upon God with perseverance. But the angels left those who made no effort to help themselves, and I lost sight of them. As

the praying ones continued their earnest cries, a ray of light from Jesus would at times come to them, to encourage their hearts, and light up their countenances.

I asked the meaning of the shaking I had seen, and was shown that it would be caused by the straight testimony

called forth by the counsel of the True Witness to the Laodiceans. This will have its effect upon the heart of the receiver, and will lead him to exalt the standard and pour forth the straight truth. Some will not bear this straight testimony. They will rise

up against it, and this will cause a shaking among God's people.

The testimony of the True Witness has not been half heeded. The solemn testimony upon which the destiny of the church hangs has been lightly esteemed, if not entirely disregarded. This testimony must work deep repentance, and all that

truly receive it will obey it and be purified.

Said the angel: "List ye!" Soon I heard a voice that sounded like many musical instruments, all in perfect strains, sweet and harmonious. It surpassed any music I had ever heard. It seemed to be so full of mercy, compassion, and elevating,

holy joy. It thrilled through my whole being. Said the angel: "Look ye!" My attention was then turned to the company I had seen, who were mightily shaken. I was shown those whom I had before seen weeping and praying with agony of spirit. The company of guardian angels around them had been doubled, and they were clothed with an armor

from their head to their feet. They moved in exact order, firmly, like a company of soldiers. Their countenances expressed the severe conflict which they had endured, the agonizing struggle they had passed through. Yet their features, marked with severe internal anguish, now shone

with the light and glory of heaven. They had obtained the victory, and it called forth from them the deepest gratitude, and holy, sacred joy.

In this article, we will provide more detail regarding the lost (not the saved) who are shaken out. So without human interjection, here is the article on "An Appeal to Live the Truth and Share It" and is provided in the original state as found in Manuscript Releases Volume 12, pages 318-328.

For weeks I have not been able to sleep after half past three o'clock. My mind is deeply exercised in regard to our condition as a people. We ought to be far in advance of any other people on the earth because we have greater light and greater knowledge of the truth, which lays us under increased accountability to advance that light and not only profess to believe the truth but to practice it. I think of all heaven being interested in the work that is going on upon the earth. 

HIGHLIGHT: Panelists at the annual conference of the American Assn. for the Advancement of Science recently discussed how to talk to religious people about the effects of climate change, the Religion News Service reports.



It is His design that the food treasures of each country shall be so prepared that they can be used in the

countries for which they are suited. As God gave manna from heaven to sustain the children of Israel, so He will now give His people in different places skill and wisdom to use the productions of these countries in preparing foods to take the place of meat. {Testimonies for the Church Volume Seven, page 124.3}

We are living in an age of intemperance. Health and life are sacrificed, by very many, to gratify their appetite for hurtful indulgences. These last days are characterized by depreciated morals and physical debility, in consequence of these indulgences and the general unwillingness to engage in physical labor. Many are suffering today from inaction and wrong habits.

The majority of the youth of this generation are fond of amusements and afraid of work. They generally lack moral courage to deny appetite and respond to the claims of duty. They have but little self-control, and become excited and passionate on the slightest occasion. Idleness and plenty of mon-

ey to spend in amusements, exciting pleasures, wines, liquors and tobacco, lay the foundation for disease and ruin. Manhood and virtue are sacrificed upon the altar of lust. Very many of every age and station in life are without principle or conscience, and with spend -thrift habits are rushing into all vices, and are corrupting society, until our world is becoming a second Sodom.

Gluttonous feasting and the indulgence of narcotics and stimulants, are carried to great lengths even by the Christian world. How many close their last precious hours of probationary time, in scenes of gaiety, feasting and amusement, where serious thoughts are not allowed to enter, where the spirit of Jesus would be unwelcome! Their last precious hours are passing while their minds are benumbed with tobacco and alcoholic liquors. There are not a few who pass directly from the dens of infamy to the sleep of death; they close their life-record among the associations of dissipation and vice. What will the awakening be at the resurrection of the unjust!

The eye of the Lord is open upon every scene of debasing amusement and profane dissipation. The words and deeds of the pleasure-lovers pass directly from these halls of vice to the Book of final records. What is the life of this class worth to the world, except as a beacon of warning to those who will be warned, not to live like these men, and die as the fool dieth. The apostle thus entreats, "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

When we pursue a course of eating and drinking that lessens physical and mental vigor, or become the prey of habits that tend to the same results, we

dishonor God, for we rob him of the service he claims from us. Those who acquire and indulge the unnatural appetite for tobacco, do this at the expense of health. They are destroying nervous energy, lessening vital force and sacrificing mental strength.

Those who profess to be the followers of

Christ yet
have this terrible sin at
their door,
cannot have a
high appreciation of the

vated estimate of eternal things. Minds that are clouded and partially paralyzed by narcotics, are easily overcome by temptation, and cannot enjoy communion with God.

Those who use tobacco can make but a poor plea to the liquor inebriate. Two-thirds of the drunkards in our land created an appetite for liquor by the use of tobacco. Those who claim that tobacco does not injure them, can be convinced of their mistake by depriving themselves of it for a few days; the trembling nerves, the giddy head, the irritability they feel, will prove to them that this sinful indulgence has bound them in slavery. It has overcome

will power. They are in bondage to a vice that is fearful in its results.

The love of tobacco is a warring lust. Means are thereby squandered that would aid in the good work of clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, and sending the truth to poor souls out of Christ. What a record will appear when the accounts of life are bal-

inflames the stomach, corrupts the blood and paves the way to stronger stimulants. It induces nervous debility, impatience and lack of self-control. Tobacco and the wine-cup follow.

We have seen that the victories gained by the "Temperance Crusade" are not often permanent. In those places

anced in the book of God! It will then appear that vast sums of money have been expended for tobacco and alcoholic liquors! For what? To ensure health and prolong life? Oh, no! To aid in the perfection of Christian character and a fitness for the society of holy angels? Oh, no! But to minister to a depraved, unnatural appetite for that which poisons and kills not only the user but those to whom he transmits his legacy of disease and imbecility. God does not propose to work a miracle to preserve our health and strength which we are daily injuring by vice and habits of hurtful indulgence.

The immediate results of meat-eating may be apparently to invigorate the system, but this is no reason for its being considered the best article of diet. The moderate use of brandy will have the same effect for the time being, but when its exciting influence is gone there follows a sense of languor and debility. Those who depend upon simple

and nutritious food, that is comparatively unstimulating in its effects, can endure more labor in the course of months and years than the

meat-eater or the liquor -drinker. They who work in the open air will feel less injury from the use of flesh-meats than those of sedentary habits, for sun and air are great helps to digestion, and do much to counteract the effect of wrong habits of eating and drinking.

All stimulants hurry the human machinery too fast, and although, for the time, activity and vigor may seem to be increased, in proportion to the irritating influence employed, there must be a reaction; a debility will follow corresponding in degree to the unnatural excite-

ment that has been produced.

When this debility is felt, something to stimulate and tone up the system is again used to give immediate relief from disagreeable languor. Nature is gradually educated to rely upon this oft-repeated remedy, until her powers are enfeebled by being often aroused to unnatural action. All persons should become acquainted with the

laws of their being. It should be an important subject of study, how to live, how to regulate labor, and how to eat and drink in reference to health.

The more simply and naturally we live the better shall we be able to resist epidemic and disease. If our habits are good and the system is not weakened by unnatural action, Nature will furnish all the stimulus that we require.

If men and women perseveringly live in accordance with the laws of life and of health, they will realize the blessed results of an entire health reform. But many make a mistake at the very commencement of their reform. They go to extremes. They carry their ideas too far. Their views in regard to healthful diet are too narrow. They have the same articles of food upon their tables, with scarcely a variation, from week to week, and from month to month. They take no pains to

> prepare fruits and grains in an inviting as well as healthful manner, and, after this course has been rigidly followed for a while, they decide that

they cannot follow out the principles of health reform, and go back to their former manner of living.

Those who set out from impulse and pursue a radical course for a time and then go back, do great injury to the cause. Many make too great and sudden changes in their diet. As the light of health reform comes to them, conscience is aroused in regard to their eating and drinking, and in their effort to change their habits of living they do not preserve a safe medium, but go to an extreme at once.

They reduce the quantity and quality of their food. This abstemiousness reduces their strength, and really injures their health. They finally conclude that they cannot live the health reform. The real facts in the case are, they never did carry out its principles. Health reform as we under-

stand it, does not consist in an impover-ished diet. The table should be well provided with fruits and grains prepared in such a manner that they are not only nutritious but inviting.

Some get the idea that to adopt the health reform is to subsist upon the very cheapest food prepared with the least labor. This is not true. It is a libel on the principles of health reform. The human system must have nourishment, and all cannot relish the same dishes. So when the table is spread with the same article of food, prepared in the same way, meal after meal and day after day, some members of the family may be well satisfied and enjoying their food very much, while others may be only able to eat sparingly of one dish and the wants of the system

will not be met; for it is a fact that some persons cannot relish, or be nourished by articles of food which others enjoy and thrive upon. But every person may do much towards educating the taste and appetite to relish plain and healthful food, such as graham bread and oat-meal gruel, and var-

ious vegetables, even if they are at first distasteful to them.

The rule which some recommend, is to eat whenever there is a sense of hunger, and to eat until satisfied. This course will lead to disease and numerous evils. Appetite at the present day is not generally natural, therefore is not a correct index to the wants of the system. It has been pampered and misdirected until it has become morbid and can no longer be a safe guide. Nature has been abused, her efforts crippled by wrong habits and indulgence in sinful luxuries, until taste and appetite are alike perverted. It is unnatural to have a craving for fleshmeats. It was not thus in the beginning. The appetite for meat has been made and educated by man. Our Creator has furnished us, in vegetables, grain, and fruits, all the elements of nutrition necessary to health and strength. Flesh-meats composed

no part of the food of Adam and Eve before their fall. If fruits, vegetables and grains are not sufficient to meet the wants of man, then the Creator made a mistake in

providing for Adam.

The habits of the age are serious obstacles to the perfecting of Christian character. Physically we are composed of what we eat, and our minds are greatly influenced by our bodies. If we subsist largely upon the flesh of animals, the animal nature is increased in like proportion. Man is sufficiently animal in his nature without cultivating those propensities by the eating of food which stimulates and excites the animal organs to activity. As these propensities are strengthened the mental and moral powers are diminished.

God did not withhold

meat from the Hebrews in the wilderness simply to show his authority, but for their good, that they might preserve physical and moral strength. He knew that the use of animal food strengthens the animal passions and enfeebles the intellect. He knew that the gratification of the appetite of the He-

moral obligations, and refuse to be controlled by the wise laws of Jehovah. Violence and rebellion would exist among them, making it impossible for them to be a pure and happy people in the land of Canaan. God knew what was best for the children of Israel, therefore he deprived them in a great measure of fleshmeats.

Satan tempted them to consider this unjust and cruel. He caused them to lust after forbidden things, because he saw that through the indulgence of perverted appetite they would become carnally-minded

and could be easily brought to do his will; the lower organs would be strengthened, while the intellectual and moral powers would be weakened.

Satan is no novice in the business of destroying souls. He well knows that if he can lead men and women into wrong habits of eating and and indispositions follow. The system is filled with humors; fevers, scrofula and cancers are the consequences. Especially is this true of those who eat swine's flesh. Yet so great is the tendency to ignore these evils, that few can be brought to realize the true effects of this sort of diet upon the

human system.

God requires that his people should be temperate in all things. The example of Christ, during that long fast in the wilderness, should teach his followers to re-

teach his followers to repulse Satan when he comes under the guise of appetite. Then may they have influence to reform those who have been led astray by indulgence, and have lost moral power to overcome the weakness and sin that has taken possession of them. Thus may Christians secure health and happiness,

QUESTION:

Is the Holy Spirit a Third Person?

COMMENT:

That is basically what a number of readers have asked. And so we have collected all comments and questions to be answered under this one question title, but here is a sampling of the actual questions posed to us:

QUESTION:

Are you a Trinitarian? Such is not in the Bible.

QUESTION:

Why did the Father and Son not speak to the Holy Spirit? Why did the Holy Spirit not speak to the Father or Son? Do we have two intercessors?

QUESTION:

Can God be the Son also? The Holy Spirit is NOT a person. [Editor's comment: Evidently this anti-third person also does not believe Jesus to be God in addition to the Father, meaning, only the Father is God and the Son is not, which makes only one God in the Godhead despite that Matthew 1:23 states, "God with us".]

QUESTION:

Isn't the Holy Spirit simply the impression of truth?

QUESTION:

Isn't the Holy Spirit simply the presence of Jesus' Spirit with us (Galatians 4:6)?

QUESTION:

Isn't the Holy Spirit simply God's [the Father] presence with us for the Holy Spirit is referred to as the Spirit of God?

QUESTION:

By elevating the Holy Spirit to be equal with the Son and the Father, does that not make the Holy Spirit an intercessor as well when we have only ONE intercessor?

ANSWER:

Before we begin answering the questions, first, our apologies if we have not summarized your specific question in the list of questions above. Second, hopefully we do not lose your focus by choosing to address all of these questions in one answer. To build up an answer to some of the questions above will eventually be repetitive and space consuming. We will be starting out in almost in a bullet point manner but eventually get deeper into the Holy Spirit topic.

As you see from the questions, many have different beliefs of the Godhead, different roles of the Holy Spirit, and many do not agree with each other except that they do not believe the Holy Spirit to be a person. So if all those that are against the third person cannot agree, how can we, then, be in agreement that there is no third person? Which option do we choose? Is the Holy Spirit God the Father or the Son or both? Or is the Holy Spirit just an impression of truth, inanimate?

Admittedly, the word "trinity" is pagan; the Biblical term is Godhead, and we ought to use the biblical term instead of the ecumenical or Catholic term. Evidently, there is an agenda in the conference to bring us in line with the use of "trinity" as many prominent speakers use it and the hymnal words were adapted to accept it. If one simply compares the song "Holy, Holy, Holy" in the 1941 hymnal to the 1985 hymnal, one would see how "God in three persons, blessed trinity" replaced "Perfect in power, in love and purity" just to note one of the changes.

Next, let us address the Holy Spirit simply being truth. It is assumed the statement is based upon John 14:17, which says, "Spirit of truth". If the Spirit is a mere object (truth), then Jesus would also be nothing more than an object as well for Jesus declared, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). So the Spirit simply being truth is not accurate at all.

Then let us address the reference of "one intercessor". The Bible clearly teaches that "For [there is] one God, and one mediator between God and men,

the man Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 2:5). It does not say only one intercessor, especially since a human may even be an intercessor. Jeremiah was told to stop his practice of intercession (Jeremiah 7:16) only when Judah had gone too far. Every prayer we offer regarding others is an intercessory prayer. Elijah was commended for offering such prayers (Romans 11:2). Paul practiced intercessory prayer as well (1 Timothy 2:1). Even Moses stood for the people. But there is only one that is THE Intercessor - "[There is] ... one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 2:5). Of all those who intercede, there is only One who can mediate because it is by the blood that He shed that makes it possible for mediation. He alone brings peace between us and the Father since sin separated us. So,

believing in the Holy

Spirit as a type of intercessor does not take away from Jesus' ministry whatsoever, nor does it set us up to be on the side of antichrist, which leads us into the next point.

Speaking of antichrist, I, being a former Catholic, understood that the Trinitarian belief is that the God of the Old Testament was the Father; Jesus was "God with us" but now sits at the right hand physically just waiting to return; and the Holy Spirit has been the God ever since – as if they really do not all agree. This poison has infiltrated Protestant beliefs, for they believe that the **Ten Commandments** were a creation of God the Father, but Jesus came and replaced them with love – just love God and love your neighbor. And the Holy Spirit simply gifts people to enjoy Christianity. Of course, we reject such theology.

Interjecting a different

thought for a moment before moving onto the next point, Satan's own counterfeit reveals a three person Godhead for as Satan counterfeits, it is usually on equal terms. Take for instance that there is one baptism. Although there are fourteen or more counterfeit choices, only one of them is ever chosen for use in baptism, be it sprinkling, triple immersion, rose petals, mass sprinkling, photograph dunking, or other means. So one baptism and one choice of counterfeit. There is one truth about death counterfeited also multiple ways, but only one is chosen, be it immediate Heaven or Hell, reincarnation, floating spirits on the earth, another dimension, etc. So if one does not believe in soul sleep, they choose to believe one of the counterfeits. Again, a one-to-one relationship. Likewise for each of the Godhead, Satan has replaced them specifically maintaining the one-toone counterfeit. The Bible says, "And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs [come] out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet" (Revelation 16:13).

The dragon (Satan) replaces the Father, the beast (antichrist or Vatican) replaces Jesus Christ, and the false prophet (Protestant America) replaces the Holy Spirit. If there were only two persons to the Godhead, there would not be three replacements.

Now let us address the Holy Spirit being referred to as God's Spirit, His Spirit, My Spirit, etc. It is no different than Jesus being referred to as, "This is my beloved Son" (Matthew 17:5) or "Son of God" (Daniel 3:25).

Again, let us interject another point of the implication that God sends His Spirit to us being some type of entity from within. If we believe that, then since we are made in the image of God, then our spirit should be referred to on equal terms, and that gives credence to the belief that we have a floating entity being released from within us upon death. It also opens up the belief of out-ofbody experiences, which is some type of spirit floating around when we are unconscious or nearing death. Both of those beliefs are nothing short of spiritualism.

Now addressing that

neither the Father nor the Son spoke to the Holy Spirit, or the other way around, the Bible says, "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come" (John 16:13). Just who is the Holy Spirit listening to? The devil? The Holy Spirit is listening to someone and it is not angels or humans, either. That pretty much leaves probably the Father, maybe the Son. But overall, how does the Holy Spirit speak? The Holy Spirit speaks through promptings and impressions guiding us into all truth. We are not to have conversation with the Holy Spirit. All glory goes to the Father.

And look carefully again at John 16:13. For the Holy Spirit to actually be the Father or the Son, that means the Father or Son would be talking to themselves. The Holy Spirit is told what to speak. He speaks what He hears. The proper understanding is that the Holy Spirit has a message from the Father and the Son; whatever is told to Him, He repeats to us.

Now we have not mentioned the numerous pronouns of "He" referring to the Holy Spirit as evidence of being a person from that verse, but someone is bound to quote, "The Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered" (Romans 8:26). The use of "itself" implies that all of the uses of "He" should be cancelled, especially since most of them are not in the original Greek, but are added words to make sense of the verse. However, since when does an "it" groan? Persons groan. According to the Bible Lexicon, "itself" in the Greek is "autos". The Greek word "autos" can be interpreted as 1) himself, herself, themselves, itself, 2) he, she, it, 3) the same. But even the words of "He" being dismissed from John 16:13 does not remove the translated word of "himself" in the same verse, which is not an added word. [As a side note, I hated referring to the Greek because now we are taking the understanding of the Bible from just a simple understanding as it reads to a so-called higher level of education. So I do not want to get into a Greek and Hebrew debate.]

Now let us turn to Ellen White's writings on this matter since many have sent us quotes using Ellen White to convince us that she did not believe in the third person, nor did the pioneers. I believe there is room for disagreement of what she believed and did not believe.

"Sin could be resisted and overcome only through the mighty agency of the Third Person of the Godhead, who would come with no modified energy, but in the fullness of divine power. It is the Spirit that makes effectual what has been wrought out by the world's Redeemer. It is by the Spirit that the heart is made pure. Through the Spirit the believer becomes a partaker of the divine nature. Christ has given His Spirit as a divine power to overcome all hereditary and cultivated tendencies to evil, and to impress His own character upon His church." {The Desire of *Ages,* page 671.2}

I have heard from previous encounters with anti-third-person people that they simply throw away the quote. The reason they throw it away is because they believe *The Desire of Ages* to be somewhat

plagiarized and in the process, the error was not caught. Although Ellen White does make a statement that some things she wrote, not necessarily The Desire of Ages, were copied because other authors wrote it out better than she could pen. God does not work on the human level nor was plagiarism an issue then, so it was permitted. But it is hard to believe that a prophet who is so hard against using infidel authors to spread error would permit such a grand error in her writings, especially in light of today when so many denounce a three person Godhead as heresy, apostasy, and of the antichrist. Then they ought to denounce Ellen White as a heretic for allowing such to be published, not once, but multiple times.

Again, as an important interjection that is unrelated to our topic but must be stated, when we get to the point of throwing out some of Ellen White's writings, we then have placed us (uninspired people) above the Spirit of Prophecy. It is no different than the many people who criticize even the King James Version of the Bible as containing some heretical content sneaked in

by erroneous copyists and even papal infiltrators. Once we start undermining pieces of the Bible it becomes untrustworthy, which should reveal Satan's agenda. Just how does one think Satan is going to fulfill the prophecy among conservatives that states, "The very last deception of Satan will be to make of none effect the testimony of the Spirit of God" {Selected Messages Book 1, page 48}. The deception is to argue evidence that shows a small group of people being privileged to holding the purest form of the Spirit of Prophecy as well as the Bible.

Continuing on with the quote:

"Of the Spirit Jesus said, 'He shall glorify Me.' The Saviour came to *glorify the Father by* the demonstration of His love; so the Spirit was to glorify Christ by revealing His grace to the world. The very image of God is to be reproduced in humanity. The honor of God, the honor of Christ, is involved in the perfection of the character of His people." {The Desire of *Ages,* page 671.3}

Other quotes include:

"The prince of the power of evil can only be held in check by the power of God in the third person of the Godhead, the Holy Spirit." {Special Testimonies for Ministers and Workers. -- No. 10, page 37.1}

"Evil had been accumulating for centuries and could only be restrained and resisted by the mighty power of the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Godhead, who would come with no modified energy, but in the fullness of divine power. Another spirit must be met; for the essence of evil was working in all ways, and the submission of man to this satanic captivity was amazing." {Testimonies to Ministers and Gospel Workers, page 392.2}

"What does God require? Perfection, nothing less than perfection. But if we would be perfect, we must put no confidence in self. Daily we must know and understand that self is not to be trusted. We need to grasp God's promises with firm faith. We need to ask for the Holy Spirit with a full realization of our own helplessness. Then when the Holy Spirit works we shall not give self the glory. The Holy Spirit will graciously take the heart into His keeping, bringing to it all

the bright beams of the Sun of Righteousness. We shall be kept by the power of God through faith." {12MR 52.1}

Ellen White specifically used the pronoun "His" when referring to the Holy Spirit, and was not even quoting scripture at the time. I say that because many could easily say that where Ellen White used "He" and "Him", she was just repeating the Bible. But even so, in quoting the Bible as being in error by using the pronoun "He", would she then be promoting the error herself? Would she not have been used to correct the error? Since she corrected no error on the use of personal pronouns that means that there is no error in the Bible when the Holy Spirit is referred to by "He", "Him", etc.

Continuing with the quotes from *Manuscript Releases Volume Twelve:*

"When we are daily under the control of God's Spirit, we shall be commandment-keeping people. We may show to the world that obedience to God's commands brings its own reward, even in this life, and in the future life eternal blessedness. Notwithstanding our profession of faith, the Lord by whom our ac-

Him." {12MR 52.2}

"It means much to commit the keeping of the soul to God. It means that we are to live and walk by faith, not trusting in or glorifying self, but looking to Jesus our advocate as the author and finisher of our faith. The Holy Spirit will do its work upon the heart that is contrite, but never can He work upon a selfimportant, selfrighteous soul. In his own wisdom such a one would mend himself. He interposes between his soul and the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will work if self will not interpose." {12MR 52.3}

Again, we have the word "its" used, but then one cannot dismiss the words "never can **He** work...". That "He" is the Holy Spirit.

"Where is our dependence? Where is our help? God's Word tells us: 'The Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He

shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you' (John 14:26). The Holy Spirit is ready to cooperate with all who will receive Him and be taught by Him. All who lay hold on the truth and are sanctified through the truth are so united with Christ that they can represent Him in word and action. They have put on Christ, and they possess a power that enables them to reveal the truth to others. May the Holy Spirit speak to the hearts of God's chosen people, that their words may be as choice as gold, as they give the bread of life to those in transgression and sin." [John 14:21, 23, 24, quoted.] {12MR 53.1}

In using the word
"Him" twice along with
the Bible quote of "He",
Ellen White is referring
to a person. Further, if
the Holy Spirit was not
separate, why, then, is
she writing, "May the
Holy Spirit speak to the
hearts of God's chosen
people" when she
should have written
"May the God speak to
the hearts of His chosen
people"?

The bottom line is that there is enough evidence to say that the conference is going too far to accommodate with the word "trinity" while at the same time the devil is appealing to conservatives too far to the other side by abandoning altogether the Third Person. The middle ground of truth appears to be believing in a three person Godhead, not trinity.

As you read this, could things like ASI requirements, people wanting to know if a ministry is conference approved, be fulfillment of control?

There will be those among us who will always want to control the work of God. to dictate even what movements shall be made when the work goes forward under the direction of the angel who joins the third angel in the message to be given to the world. God will use ways and means by which it will be seen that He is taking the reins in His own hands.
