### Our Father

- What does that make us?
- 1 John 3:18, Little Children

### Which art in heaven

- As opposed to the imitator on earth, but why else mention Heaven?
- Matthew 6:20, to get our eyes off of the earthly concerns and put them upon the miracle working location where God dwells

### Hallowed be thy name.

- Why recognize that His name is Hallowed? Revelation 14:1, 144,000 have the Father's name written in their foreheads
- What gets the Father's name there? Revelation 7:3, being sealed
- Whose name is in competition? Revelation 14:11, the Antichrist Beast
- So, let us Hallow God's name by allowing Him to seal us

### Thy kingdom come.

- What kingdom? Luke 17:20-21, invisible
- How is it within us? Matthew 4:17, by repenting
- So we are asking through these words that the Kingdom of God, through repentance, happen to us, which is the born again experience.

- Specifically, what is God's will? Psalms 40:8, Keeping the Ten Commandments

- So we are asking God to change our desires
