Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

- John 8:31-32
- *Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.*
- Belief is not sufficient alone
- We are to continue in His (not our) Word
- And we are to KNOW THE TRUTH -

Does Jesus Speak to you audibly today?

- No!
- Moses was the last person to have that privilege (Exodus 33:11) -

So where are we to Get Jesus' words so as to be His disciple?

- John 17:20
- *Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word.*
- “These” refer to His disciples
- It is through their word that we receive the words of Jesus -

Who are those disciples?

- John 21:25
- *And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.*
- It's some of the New Testament Writers
- Matthew, John, Peter -

What about others?

- 2 Peter 1:21
- *For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake [as they were] moved by the Holy Ghost.*
- That's all of the Old Testament Writers!
- That just leaves Mark, Luke, James, Paul, Jude -

What about Mark?

- Acts 4:36
- *And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas....*
- Barnabas listened verbally to the apostles
- Acts 15:37
- *And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark.*
- And Mark listened to Barnabas -

What about Jude?

- Jude 1:1
- *Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, [and] called*
- He admits to whom he listened to -

What about James?

- James 1:1
- *James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.*
- He admits to whom he listened to -

What about Paul?

- Acts 26:14-18
- *And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; Delivering thee from the people, and [from] the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, [and] to turn [them] from darkness to light, and [from] the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.*
- Paul had a personal invitation -

What about Luke?

- 2 Timothy 4:11
- *Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry.*
- Luke was taught of Paul
- Note that Mark was also taught of Paul
- So Jesus said that He was praying that all would believe through their word, which is written -

But what are we hearing?

- Scriptures are too old
- They are too contradictory
- They are full of errors
- All that is important is that we believe that Jesus saves
- You can't take that stuff literally -

Are the scriptures too old?

- Then why did God have the original Old Testament unearthed in modern times proving a translation to be nearly 99.4% accurate with the KJV?
- 1 Corinthians 10:11
- *Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.*
- Paul, in vision, saw the application of the scriptures to be specifically for the last generation on earth -

Are the scriptures contradictory?

- 1 Corinthians 14:33
- For God is not [the author] of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
- God is the AUTHOR
- The books of the Bible were but written in the WRITER'S own knowledge of what they saw in vision -

Are the scriptures contradictory?

- Isaiah 28:9-10
- *Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? [them that are] weaned from the milk, [and] drawn from the breasts. For precept [must be] upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, [and] there a little*
- Scriptures are contradictory if not studied right! -

Are the scriptures full of errors?

- As said already, the Dead Sea Scrolls are with in 99.4% accurate of KJV
- The only error is found in modern translations that contradict the KJV
- Since God is the AUTHOR, is He in error?
- And do you really think that Jesus would not have corrected the errors in His day, so since He was silent on errors, the Old Testament is True
- And do you really think God, in preserving the Bible through book burnings and other attacks throughout the centuries would allow simple error to infiltrate it? -

All that matters is believing in Jesus saving?

- Matthew 28:18-20
- *And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, [even] unto the end of the world. Amen.*
- That teaching part is after baptism, which means if we reject what is being taught to be observed (obeyed), our baptism is meaningless

All that matters is believing in Jesus saving?

- 1 Peter 4:17
- *For the time [is come] that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if [it] first [begin] at us, what shall the end [be] of them that obey not the gospel of God?*
- Lack of obedience is a lost condition, once saved or not

All that matters is believing in Jesus saving?

- Romans 6:16
- *Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?*
- Obeying one or the other -

Do you really take that stuff literally?

- Matthew 4:3-4
- *And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.*

Do you really take that stuff literally?

- Matthew 4:5-7
- *Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in [their] hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.*

Do you really take that stuff literally?

- Matthew 4:8-10
- *Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for **it is written**, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.*

Do you really take that stuff literally?

- John 5:39
- *Search the scriptures*; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- If the scriptures were good enough for Jesus, they are good enough for me
- And seeing He commanded us to search the scriptures, search the scriptures I will -

How did so many stray from holding fast to the scriptures?

- 2 Thessalonians 2:3
- *Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition*
- There was a predicted falling away from the scriptures

How did so many stray from holding fast to the scriptures?

- 2 Timothy 4:3-4
- *For the time will come when they will **not endure sound doctrine**; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be **turned unto fables**.*

How did so many stray from holding fast to the scriptures?

- 2 Peter 2:1
- *But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.*

How did so many stray from holding fast to the scriptures?

- 1 John 2:18-22
- *Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would [no doubt] have continued with us: but [they went out], that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us. But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things. I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth. Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. -*

What determines if you are on the side of Antichrist?

- 2 John 1:7-9
- *For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward. Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. -*

What doctrines does Jesus have that Antichrist fights?

- Jesus says: John 8:32
- *And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.*
- Antichrist says: Daniel 8:12
- *And an host was given [him] against the daily [sacrifice] by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.*
- Jesus says there is truth; antichrist says there is no truth (or everyone can have their own version of truth) -

What doctrines does Jesus have that Antichrist fights?

- Jesus says: John 14:23
- *Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.*
- Antichrist says: Revelation 13:5
- *And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies*
- Blasphemies are: Mark 7:13
- *Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition*
- Jesus says follow His Word; antichrist says to follow what he says, even traditions over the Word of God -

What doctrines does Jesus have that Antichrist fights?

- Jesus says: John 14:15
- *If ye love me, keep my commandments.*
- Antichrist says: Daniel 7:25
- *And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws*
- Jesus asks us to keep the commandments; antichrist says that he thinks he can change them -

What doctrines does Jesus have that Antichrist fights?

- Jesus says: Mark 2:27-28
- *And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.*
- Antichrist says: Daniel 7:25
- *And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws*
- Jesus made the Sabbath for MAN; antichrist says that he thinks he can change that day -

What does the Catholic Church Say?

- In 2003, www.immaculateheart.com/maryonline repeated ROME'S CHALLENGE from FEBRUARY 24, 1893
- The challenge issued by Rome over 100 years ago remains: **Either the Catholic Church is right, or the Seventh-day Adventists are right. There can be no other choice. And if one choose neither, then the whole doctrine of Sola Scriptura collapses, and with it, the pillar upon which all of Protestantism stands.**

What one has left is an invented religion, an invented God, and an invented set of beliefs that suits man's purpose and not the Creator's. Like Satan and Luther before them, Protestants have spoken the creed. In action and in thought, if not in word. "I Will Not Serve..."

The challenge remains – yet you will find no response, not from any Evangelical, Fundamentalist, or mainline Protestant denomination anywhere. Ultimately, it is the clear authority of the Catholic Church as vested in Her by God Himself, that rules the day. -

What is commanded in the Ten Commandments?

- Exodus 20:8-11
- *Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But **the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God**: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates: For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.*
- Wait! No wonder so many are against the commandment!
- It acknowledges that creation week is literal since it is a pattern to be kept -

Is Creation literal?

- 2 Timothy 4:4 Said that Christians would be turned to fables.
- To not believe in a literal Creation means that the story of creation is but a fable
- That then means the flood is also treated as a fable
- Where do the fables stop?
- Is eternal life a fable?
- Is God a fable
- If we pick and choose what is a fable and what is not, everything becomes suspect -

Is Creation and the Flood literal?

- Matthew 24:38
- *For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,*
- Luke 17:29
- *But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed [them] all.*

Is Creation and the Flood literal?

- Matthew 12:40
- *For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.*
- Mark 10:6
- *But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.*
- Everything Christians call fables today, Jesus believed in
- If He believed all of this to be literal, so do I -

What about scientific evidence?

- 1 Timothy 6:20-21
- *O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane [and] vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the faith.*
- Remember, most scientists are atheists
- Atheists initial hypothesis is that there is NO GOD!
- Too many evidences that is being denied regarding the age of the planet -

What about scientific evidence?

- Piles of sea shells on top of Mount Everest
- Sand eroding into the sea would have wiped out all land 100x over (no exaggeration)
- Even species thought to be extinct millions of years ago are alive today
- The amount of dust on the moon indicates a much shorter life span
- Undigested grass in dinosaurs when grass supposedly came after the dinosaurs
- Bone marrow found in dinosaurs
- Zero transitional fossils [more than 1 missing link; they are all missing]
- Many buried items that go through many layers of earth each taught to be millions of years old
- 300 independent ancient writings confirming a universal flood -

What evidence is given for a literal creation week?

- Genesis 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31
- *And the evening and the morning were the _____ day.*
- First, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth day.
- Specifically, Genesis 1:14
- *And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years*
- Can't let such be telling seasons, days, and years if creation were periods of eons -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:1
- *Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left [us] of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.*
- We are to enter into HIS REST
- We do not create a Sabbath but simply remember to keep it -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:2
- *For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard [it].*
- Contrary to popular belief, Sabbath keepers have the gospel
- Also, those that do not keep the Sabbath because they have faith actually don't -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:3
- *For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.*
- Contrary to popular belief, Sabbath keepers do BELIEVE! -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:4
- *For he spake in a certain place of the seventh [day] on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.*
- Not a Sabbath day but the SEVENTH DAY SABBATH
- Also note that the writer of Hebrews confirms a literal day and not eon of time -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:5-6
- *And in this [place] again, If they shall enter into my rest. Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief*
- It REMAINS -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:7
- Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, *To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.*
- It is limited to that certain day [7th] -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:8-9
- *For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day. There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.*
- Since Jesus did not speak of a different day, it REMAINS the SAME day -

Didn't Jesus do away with the Sabbath?

- Hebrews 4:10
- *For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God [did] from his.*
- And there is our example -

But aren't we saved by GRACE?

- Romans 6:1-4
- *What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? **God forbid.** How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.*
- Yes, not to keep sinning so we get a lot of grace
- Baptism new life -

What is SIN?

- 1 John 3:4-7
- *Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law. And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin. Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him. Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.*
- Righteous and not a legalist -

But aren't we saved by FAITH?

- Romans 3:31
- *Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law. -*

Didn't Jesus take away the law?

- Matthew 5:17-18
- *Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.*
- Heaven and earth are still here so then the law is too -

What law was taken away then?

- Colossians 2:14-17
- Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath [days]: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Christ.
- Commandments are not ORDINANCES
- Meat, drink, holyday, new moon, Sabbath days are all quotes from Leviticus 23 dealing with Feast Days. No more lamb sacrifices as they were a shadow of Jesus -

What do the last day people have?

- Revelation 12:17
- *And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.*
- Revelation 12:9 dragon ... called the Devil, and Satan
- Jeremiah 6:2 I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate [woman]
- Isaiah 51:16 Zion, Thou [art] my people -

What condition did Jesus place?

- Matthew 19:16-19
- *And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? [there is] none good but one, [that is], God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and [thy] mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.*
- Those are the TEN COMMANDMENTS -

Aren't there only 2 commandments now?

- Matthew 22:37-40
- *Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second [is] like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.*
- To HANG ALL THE LAW is to summarize all 10 commandments into 2 as well as all the rest of the scriptures, which is just expounding it
- First 4 are loving God; Last 6 are loving neighbor -

Who will be lost?

- 2 Thessalonians 2:10
- *And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.*
- Those that do not love the truth enough

Who will be lost?

- Matthew 7:13-15
- *Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide [is] the gate, and **broad [is] the way, that leadeth to destruction**, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait [is] the gate, and narrow [is] the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. **Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.***
- WOLVES? Jude 1:4
- *For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, **turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness**, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.*
- They teach GRACE saves you in sinning; GRACE permits disregarding the Word; GRACE permits disobeying the commandments

Who will be lost?

- Matthew 7:21-23
- *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*
- Those living and exemplifying iniquity [sin] will be lost despite being Christian! -

Who will be saved?

- Romans 2:13
- *For not the hearers of the law [are] just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.*
- Luke 8:15
- *But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep [it], and bring forth fruit with patience.*
- Revelation 22:14
- *Blessed [are] they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. -*
