# How Does Jesus Symbolically Return?

➤ Revelation 19:11-16

➤ *And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him [was] called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes [were] as a flame of fire, and on his head [were] many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he [was] clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God**. And the armies [which were] in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a **sharp sword**, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on [his] vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. -*

# What is the Main Connection With the Sharp Sword?

- Hebrews 4:12
- For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Matches what is written on Jesus' thigh in Revelation 19 -

# What More Specifically Is Connected?

- Hebrews 4:4
- *For he spake in a certain place of the seventh [day] on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.*
- It is the Sabbath of the Seventh-day and not Sunday -

# But Are Not the Commandments Done Away With?

- Romans 6:15
- *What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.*
- Romans 3:31
- *Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.*
- Romans 7:7
- *What shall we say then? [Is] the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet. -*

# Did Jesus Do Away With the Commandments?

➤ Matthew 15:3-9

➤ *But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition? For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death. But ye say, Whosoever shall say to [his] father or [his] mother, [It is] a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; And honour not his father or his mother, [he shall be free]. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition. [Ye] hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with [their] lips; but their heart is far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.*

# Did Jesus Do Away With the Commandments?

- Mark 7:9-13
- *And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition. For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death: But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, [It is] Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; [he shall be free]. And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother; Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.*
- Jesus taught to keep what Moses taught (Mosaic Law)
- No! It is Pharisee Law that has been stripped -

# How Important Is the Ten Commandments?

- James 2:10-12
- *For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.*
- Liberty is to be made free -

# How Does Jesus' Words And James' Words Connect?

- John 8:32
- *And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.*
- Psalms 119:142
- *Thy righteousness [is] an everlasting righteousness, and thy law [is] the truth.*
- So the Law is truth and truth makes you free therefore keeping the law sets you free from sin-

# What Did Jesus Come To Do?

- Matthew 1:21
- *And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.*
- Romans 11:27
- *For this [is] my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.*
- 1 John 3:5
- *And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin. -*

# What Is Sin?

- 1 John 3:4
- *Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.*
- So by Bible definition, since we have sin that needs taken away, the law still exists -

# Are You Born Again?

- 1 John 3:9
- **Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin;** for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.
- 1 John 3:6
- **Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not:** whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him. -

# Is It One Strike And Out?

- 1 John 2:1
- *My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:*
- 1 John 1:9
- *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.* -

# Did Not Jesus Make It Easier?

- Matthew 5:21-22
- *Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.*

# Did Not Jesus And Apostles Make It Easier?

- Matthew 5:27-28
- *Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.*
- Romans 7:6-7
- *But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not [in] the oldness of the letter. What shall we say then? [Is] the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet. -*

# What Law Was Done Away With?

- Hebrews 10:1
- *For the law having a shadow of good things to come*, [and] not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.
- Colossians 2:14-17
- *Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances* that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath [days]: *Which are a shadow of things to come*; but the body [is] of Christ.

# What Meat and Drink?

➤ Leviticus 23:13

➤ And the meat offering thereof [shall be] two tenth deals of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto the LORD [for] a sweet savour: and the drink offering thereof [shall be] of wine, the fourth [part] of an hin.

➤ Leviticus 23:18

➤ And ye shall offer with the bread seven lambs without blemish of the first year, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be [for] a burnt offering unto the LORD, with their meat offering, and their drink offerings, [even] an offering made by fire, of sweet savour unto the LORD.

➤ Leviticus 23:37

➤ These [are] the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim [to be] holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon his day:

# What Sabbath Days?

- Leviticus 23:24
- *Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first [day] of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.*
- Leviticus 23:32
- *It [shall be] unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth [day] of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.*
- Leviticus 23:39
- *Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day [shall be] a sabbath, and on the eighth day [shall be] a sabbath.*
- The feast days again -

# Remember What the Fourth Commandment Direction Is?

- Exodus 20:8
- *Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates: For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.*
- Points not forward but back to creation -

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- Points not forward to Christ but backward to creation -

# Did Jesus Do Away With All of the Levitical Laws?

- Matthew 23:23
- *Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.*
- He did not say, stop tithing and do judgment, mercy, and faith
- He said, “ought ye to have done it” BUT don’t forget the other -

# Where Is the Original Set of Commandments?

- Revelation 11:19
- *And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. -*

# How Do We Know That Means the Ten Commandments?

- Hebrews 8:5
- *Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, [that] thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.*
- This is why the physical tabernacle is no longer important since the Heavenly one has been activated

# How Do We Know That Means the Ten Commandments?

- Deuteronomy 10:1
- *At that time the LORD said unto me, Hew thee two tables of stone like unto the first, and come up unto me into the mount, and make thee an ark of wood. And I will write on the tables the words that were in the first tables which thou brakest, and thou shalt put them in the ark.*
- Commandments are in the Ark
- Moses received 2 copies, breaking the first
- No originals -

# Who Before Moses Kept the Commandments?

- Genesis 26:5
- *Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.*
- They existed before Moses -

# Who Broke the Commandments?

- Genesis 4:6-7
- *And the LORD said unto **Cain**, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen? If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee [shall be] his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.*
- [Reminder, sin is the transgression of the law]

# Who Broke the Commandments?

- Romans 5:12-14
- Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: (For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law. Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.
- [Reminder, sin is the transgression of the law] -

# Who Broke the Commandments?

- 1 John 3:8
- *He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.*
- [Reminder, sin is the transgression of the law]
- So the devil sinned, before earth even existed, before Adam and Eve sinned-

# How Long Have and Will the Commandments Be?

- Psalms 119:142
- *Thy righteousness [is] an everlasting righteousness, and thy law [is] the truth.*
- 2 Peter 2:21
- *For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known [it], to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.*
- Romans 8:4
- *That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. -*

# Are We Sure the Commandments Are Everlasting?

- Genesis 2:2-3
- And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.
- He established His existing Sabbath on earth

# Are We Sure the Commandments Are Everlasting?

- Isaiah 66:22-23
- For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, [that] from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.
- Eternity of Sabbath keeping -

# What Does the Devil Do?

- John 10:10
- *The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.*
- Includes:
  - Stealing time from God (hardly any church goes)
  - Stealing time from Families (always working)
  - Slowly killing us by worrying 7 days a week
  - Slowly killing us by lack of rest
  - Destroy us in the end by having us break the commandments -

# How Does Breaking the Commandments Lose Eternal Life?

- Revelation 22:14
- *Blessed [are] they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.*
- James 2:10-11
- *For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. -*

# What Does Satan Use To Cause People To Break the Commandments?

- 2 John 1:7-9
- *For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward. Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. -*

# What Does Antichrist Do?

- Daniel 7:25
- *And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time. -*

# Who Claims To Be Able To Do That?

- In the Convert's Catechism of Catholic Doctrine
- Q. *Which is the Sabbath day?*
- A. *Saturday is the Sabbath day.*
- Q. *Why do we observe Sunday instead of Saturday?*
- A. *We observe Sunday instead of Saturday because the Catholic Church, in the Council of Laodicea, (AD 336) transferred the solemnity from Saturday to Sunday....*
- Q. *Why did the Catholic Church substitute Sunday for Saturday?*
- A. *The Church substituted Sunday for Saturday, because Christ rose from the dead on a Sunday, and the Holy Ghost descended upon the Apostles on a Sunday.*
- Q. *By what authority did the Church substitute Sunday for Saturday?*
- A. *The Church substituted Sunday for Saturday by the plenitude of that divine power which Jesus Christ bestowed upon her!*
